Are you interested in a way to keep your kids thinking creatively at home? SCAMPER is a wonderful tool to get the entire family thinking together. SCAMPER works well with ideas, problems, things, people, history, and machines.

S=Substitute: Remove some part (or idea) and replace it with something else.

C=Combine: Combine 2 or more things (or ideas) to make it better.

A=Adapt: Change some part (or idea) so that it works where it didn't work before.

M=Modify: Modify an attribute- change the size, shape, color, attitude, position, history, etc. to make it better.

P=Put to another use: Think about why this exists, what it is used for, and what it's supposed to do. Now suggest a new and unusual purpose.

E=Eliminate: Remove some pieces of it to make it work better.

R= Reverse/Rearrange: Change the direction, make it up-side down, go to the opposite idea; or change the pieces around to make it work better.

Example: Let's SCAMPER a Reese's peanut butter cup!

S= Fill the chocolate cup with marshmallows instead of peanut butter. Yum!

C= Combine the crunch of cookies with the creaminess of the peanut butter for the filling.

A= Change the wrapper so it doesn't get stuck on the bottom and waste chocolate!

M= Make the cups bigger by triple stacking cups!

P= Use the cups as a cupcake decoration. It becomes turkey feathers when placed on its side. Add a body with a malt ball.

E= Eliminate the need to buy them at the store. They should be shipped daily directly to one's house.

R= Rearrange the order of the candy...peanut butter on the outside and chocolate on the inside.


NEWS FROM THE EAGLE'S NEST
